

By purchasing a unifant ticket you agree with the following terms and conditions:

Unifant tickets are non-refundable and assigned to name. Please bring your printed ticket and identification to show at the gate. We will have a guestlist from to keep trace of guest arrivals.

Fire consciousness

The death rate in Portugal due to forrestfires is the highest in Europe. The land is extremely dry during the summer months and that combined with the occasional strong winds makes the tiniest spark a potential threat. By law campfires are forbidden from May 1st until the the first rains in autumn.

During Unifant there will be no fires allowed at all. Also we ask you to please be very conscious while smoking. Sparks do travel with the wind and set fire to dry grass in an instant. Cigarette buds should never be thrown on the ground. Instead, keep them with you until you reach a garbage bin.

Drugs and substances

Unifant is a drugfree festival. The villages around are traditional and for the most part not in favor of druguse. We share and respect these values and ask you to do likewise.

Casualties

The wide terrain of Companhia has a few characteristics to be conscious about:

- Some of the fields are separated by terrace walls up to a few meters. At night it can be extremely dark and without a light it is easy to miss the height difference. Please make sure you bring a flashlight and use it when crossing the land in dark.
- Water at Companhia comes from three seperate wells located on the land. These wells are used to water our gardens and to supply the kitchen and bathroom. With so many people present at the same time we fear to reach the bottom of the wells, making the water less suitable for drinking. Therefore, we ask you to limit your water use and get your drinking water at the bar.
- In summertime the land is home to insects, snakes and scorpions. Even though we have not had any problems with them so far, it is wise to keep in mind they like to hide under and between hot stones and wet areas. Keep your tent closed and do not keep food in there which can attract them. Don't be too alarmed: a bite does hurt but none of the animals are deadly poisonous.

Please note that everybody has their own responsibility to stay save. Companhia tries to inform and prevent casualties but cannot be held responsible in case of injury or damage.

For urgent matters we have a first aid post at the festival. Transportation in case of emergency will be available. Make sure you arrive with the nessacery insurance documents.
